T-BALL

- Tot T-Ball - 4 year olds only - Tuesdays/Thursdays/Saturdays
- T-Ball - 5 & 6 year olds - Mondays/Wednesdays/Saturdays

Excel games played at Foxx & LHS Fields. Games officiated by certified umpires from Diamond Umpire Association.
